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## **Winter Maintenance RFP Addendum #1**

Following the non-mandatory pre-bid conference, there were a few questions raised. Some of them were general while one resulted in a correction/addition to one of the contracts. See below for more details.

Q: Water St from Cross St to the terminus does not appear to be in either contract. Who will be taking care of that section of Water St?

A: Water St, from Cross to the terminus, will be included in the Town-wide contract. The total length of this section of road is approximately 0.2 miles and will be included as a Low-Priority road. See the Town-wide Winter Maintenance RFP for more details.

Q: How much material can be stored in the town's structures?

A: The wood structure is meant to store salted sand. The estimated volume of stored materials should not exceed 1,800 cubic yards. The fabric top structure is for the storage of salt and should not exceed 100 tons.

Q: Which contract takes priority if salt supply is running low?

A: This will be determined based on the conditions, but due to the snow-discharge permit, the downtown contract will likely take priority. We will work with the supplier to keep the supply stocked.
